Traineeships

If you would like to get a taster of a career with the EU institutions, why not apply for a traineeship?

Each year, around 1,900 young people are offered the chance to increase their professional skills, develop their personal qualities, and enhance their EU knowledge through the EU trainee programmes. Most of the EU institutions organise traineeships for young university graduates, each lasting usually between 3 and 5 months.

Traineeships are available in a wide range of fields and offer a great insight into the work of the EU. The content of the job largely depends on the service you are assigned to. Opportunities are available in the fields of competition law, human resources, environmental policy, communication and many more.

The selection procedures for traineeships are run individually by the EU Institutions and agencies themselves. You can see below some of the opportunities available. Please note that maybe not all available opportunities are displayed on this site.

Elementos a tener en cuenta en la motivación

- El candidato debe escribir un texto corto, estructurado y que se entienda bien. Debe responder a las preguntas ¿por qué quiere trabajar en la Comisión? ¿por qué está interesado?

Se tiene que presentar detalladamente los estudios, idiomas, otras habilidades (programas de informática, otras “soft skills” como capacidad para comunicar, trabajar en equipo, etc) y la experiencia laboral, como becas, intercambios, trabajo voluntario, etc.



Desde mi experiencia como evaluadora unos consejos:

- Poneos en la piel del evaluador: tienes un par de días para evaluar a unos 50 candidatos, y esta evaluación se realiza voluntariamente y además del trabajo
- Frases cortas y claras
- Que el texto fluya, evitad corta y pega (se nota al leerlo)
- Mirad las faltas de ortografía y de escritura. Releedlo, imprimidlo y pedid a alguien que os lo revise (queda muy mal decir que tienes un C2 en inglés y presentar un texto lleno de errores)
- Debéis dar buenas razones
- Explicad bien vuestras habilidades, qué habéis hecho durante vuestros estudios, trabajos, prácticas, voluntariados, etc



- ▶ **LLEVA TIEMPO PREPARARLA, NO LO DEJEIS PARA EL ULTIMO MOMENTO!!!!**

Apply in January 2024 for the October 2024 traineeship




